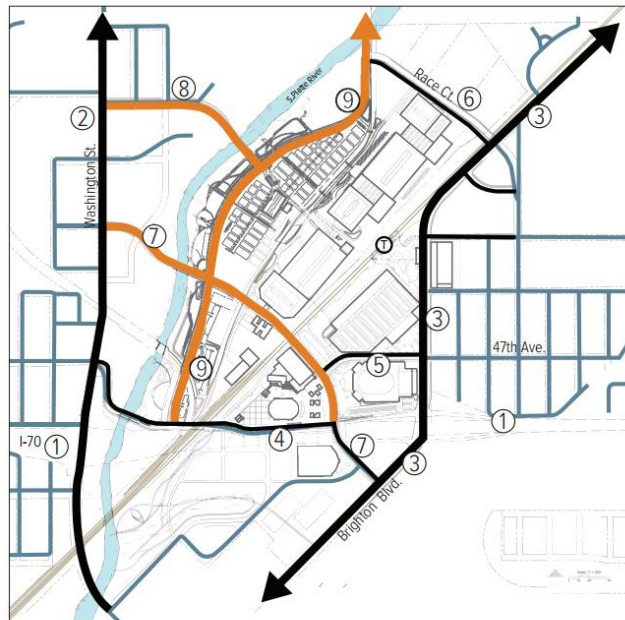

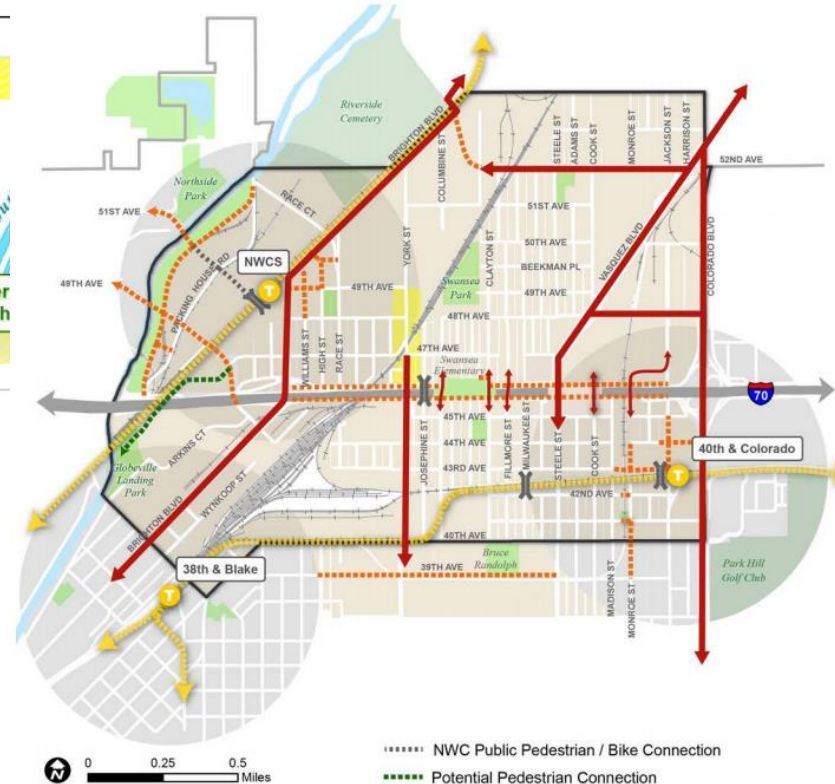
NDCC COMPLETED PLANS
