The Study Area is defined as the National Western Stock Show and Coliseum area, with the broader influence area including the surrounding neighborhoods of Elyria Swansea, Globeville, Five Points, Cole, Clayton and RINO. The Mayor's Office of the National Western Center (NWCO) Parking and Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Study will address the needs for the existing National Western Stock Show complex and Coliseum, and the future phased development of the National Western Center (NWC) campus. The study will include strategies and recommendations for parking, multi-modal opportunities and TDM improvements that will be scalable in coordination with redevelopment of the National Western Center campus, and will leverage other transportation infrastructure investments by the City and RTD in the area. The Plan will address vehicular, transit, bicycle and pedestrian traffic and the network will tie into the larger regional network being studied under the North Denver Cornerstone Collaborative (NDCC) Master Mobility Plan.
