

HIC Organization Chart











- Due 14 calendar days before bid due date
- How to get prequalified?

 - Return signed & completed form & attachments to:
 - City and County of Denver Department of Public Works Prequalification Section, Dept. 614 201 West Colfax Avenue Denver, Colorado 80202
 - Subcontractors need not apply, only primes






