



# 44th & Broadway Progress

### Project Overview

Denver's Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DOTI) is improving pedestrian access, including new sidewalk sections, curbs, gutters, ramps, stairs, railings and lighting, along 44th Avenue between Delaware Street and Broadway. These improvements will complement the neighborhood aesthetic and travel along 44th Avenue while improving safety and access for pedestrians traveling along this corridor.

The 44th Avenue & Broadway project is funded primarily by Elevate Denver Bond dollars approved by voters in November 2017. The bond included \$47.7 million to fill existing gaps in the sidewalk network, with \$17 million specifically earmarked for the Globeville, Elyria and Swansea neighborhoods.
