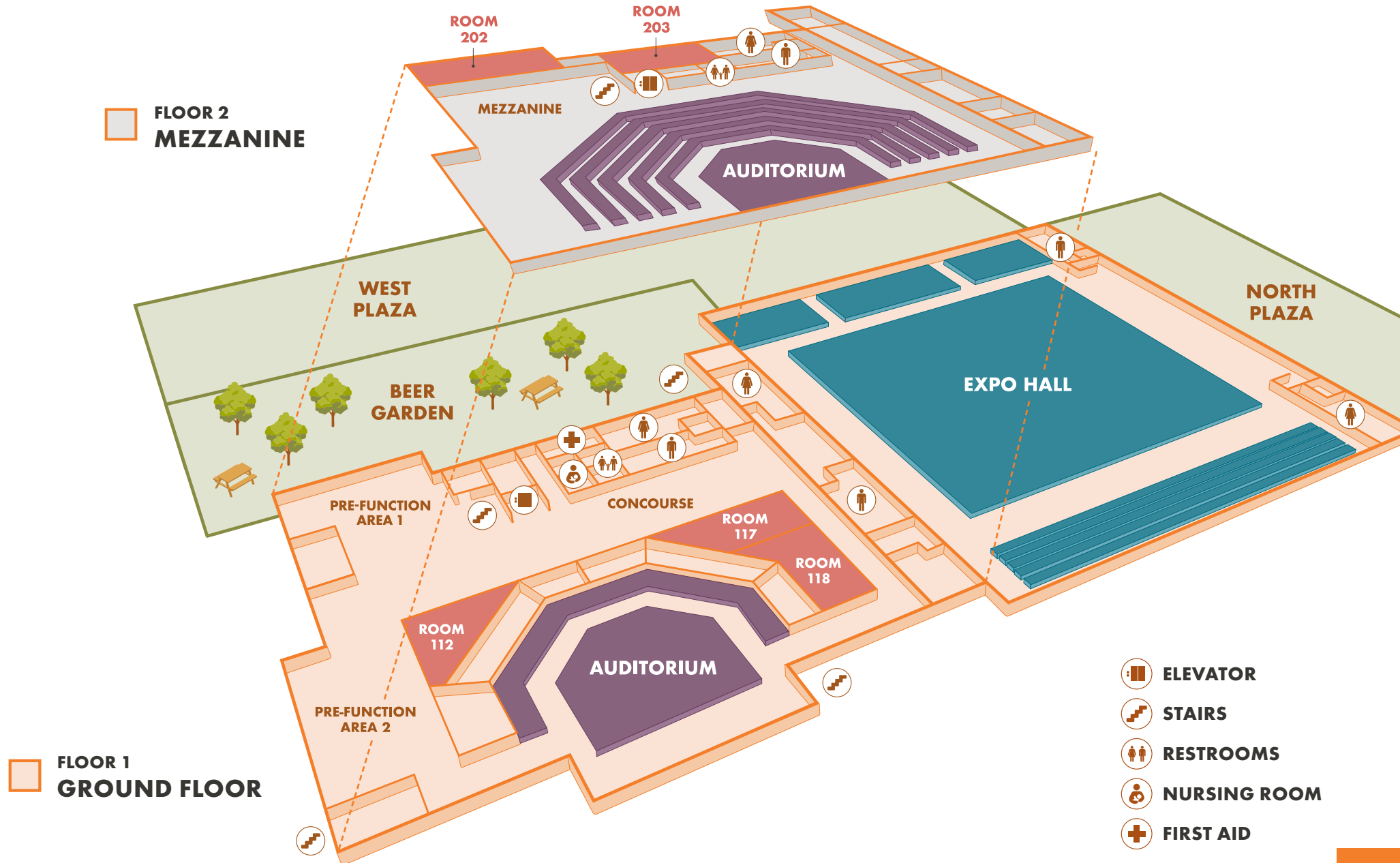

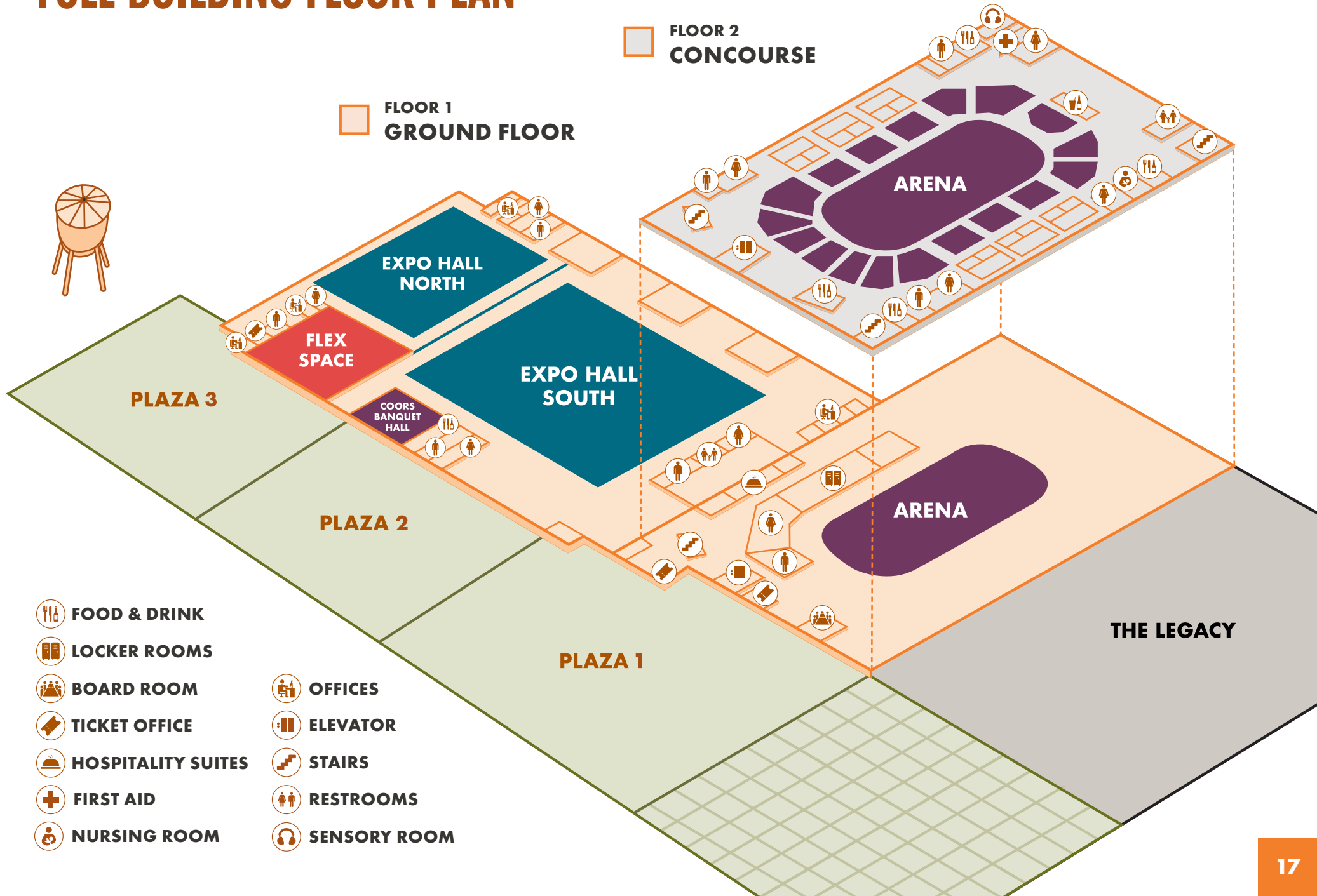

The CoBank Arena is the centerpiece of the Livestock Center — a large-scale venue designed to host major events with impact.

With a 23,896-square-foot arena floor (19,158 sq. ft. with bleachers pulled out), professional rigging grid, and 65-foot 6-inch clearance, it delivers the flexibility needed for concerts, rodeos, sporting events, festivals, conventions, graduations, and more. The arena features 3,742 fixed seats, 12 premium suites, and configurations up to 6,100 for center stage or 5,200 for end stage. Supported by advanced lighting, sound, and staging that create a turnkey canvas for powerful live experiences.

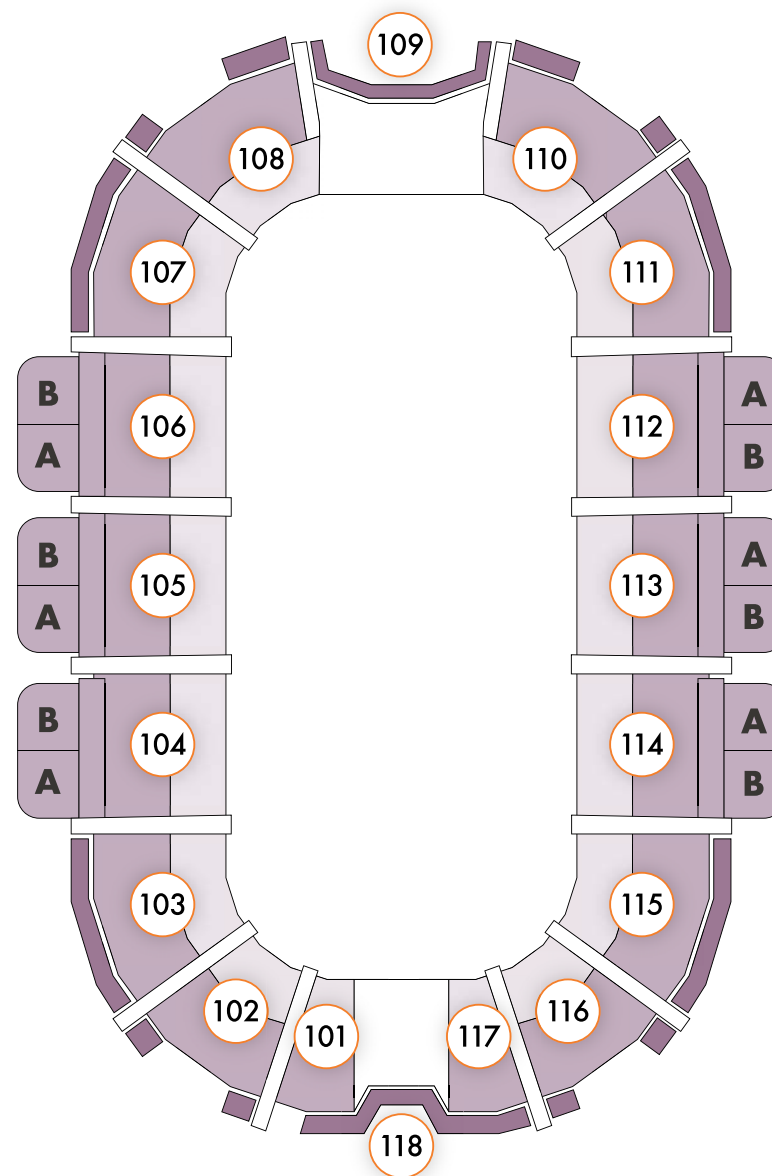

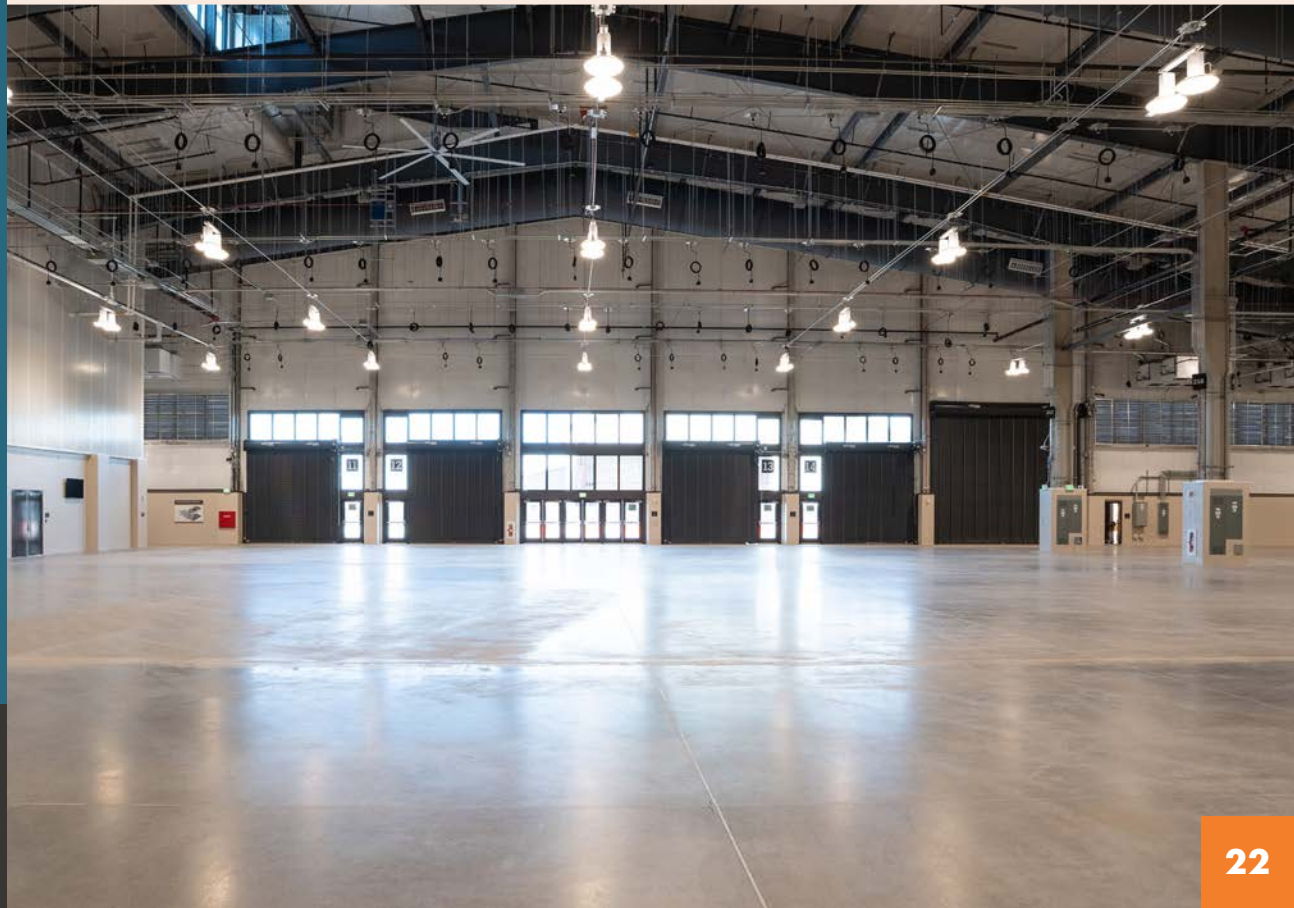
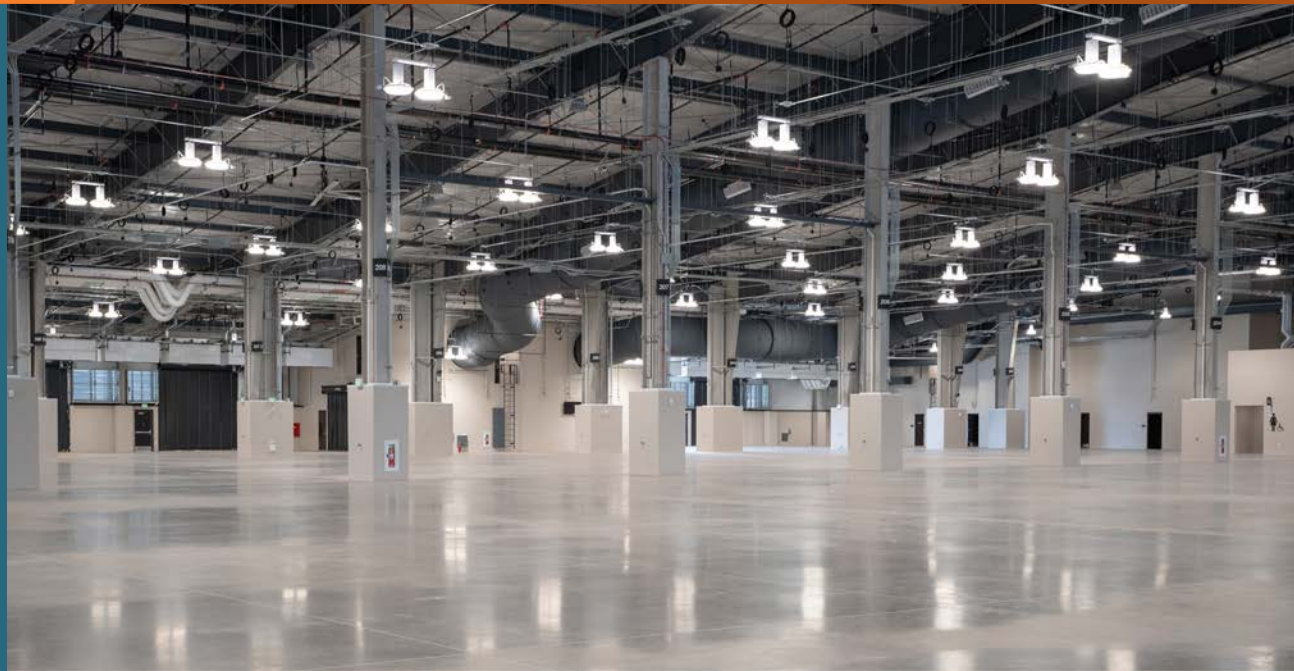

With more than 150,000 square feet between them, 25-foot ceiling clearance with structural rigging, extensive overhead and column power, water hookups on 45 columns, and multiple docks and roll-up doors for easy access, they're built for efficient, high-impact events. A movable partition allows the halls to function as one continuous space or as two distinct venues, giving you the flexibility to right-size any event.

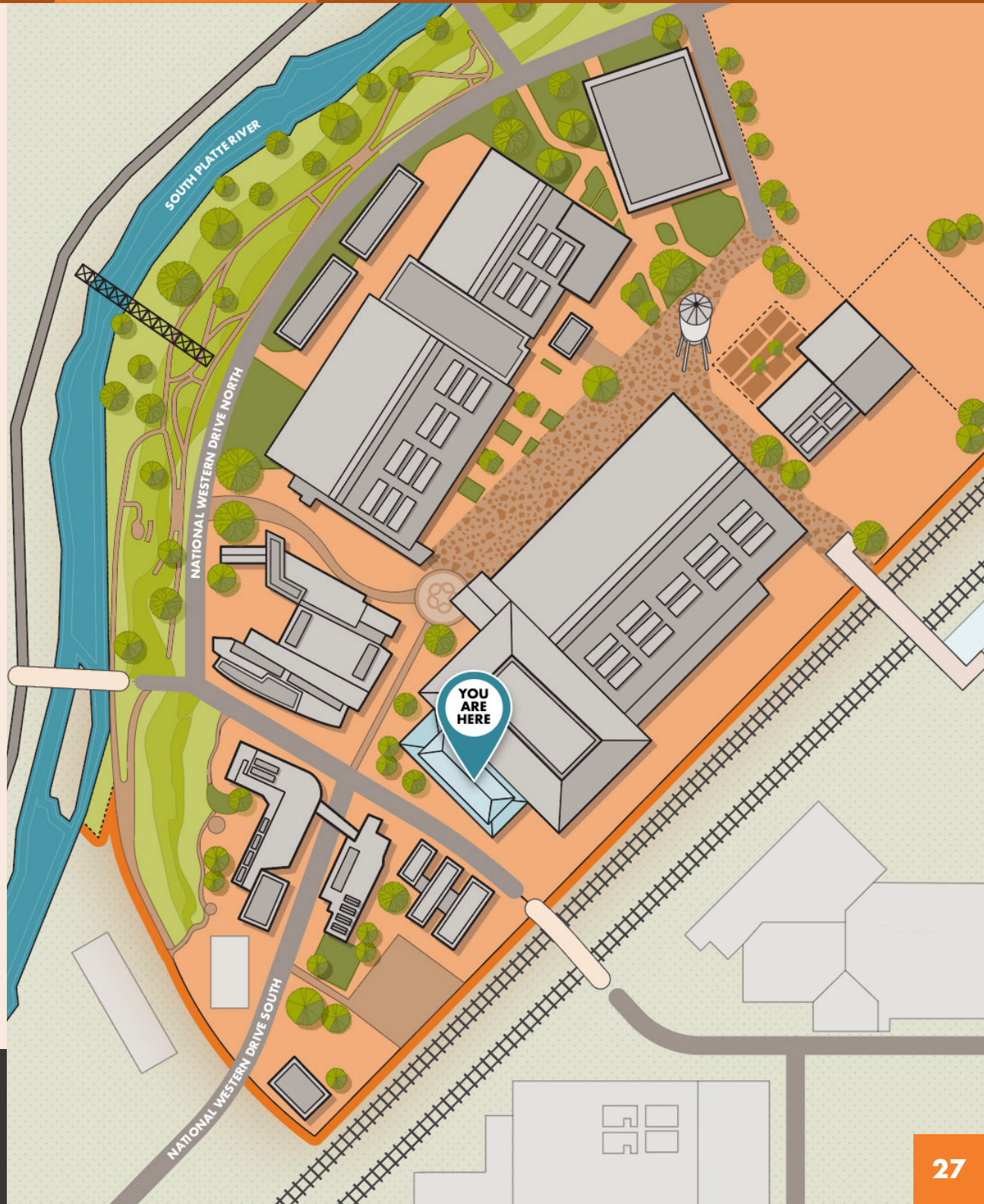

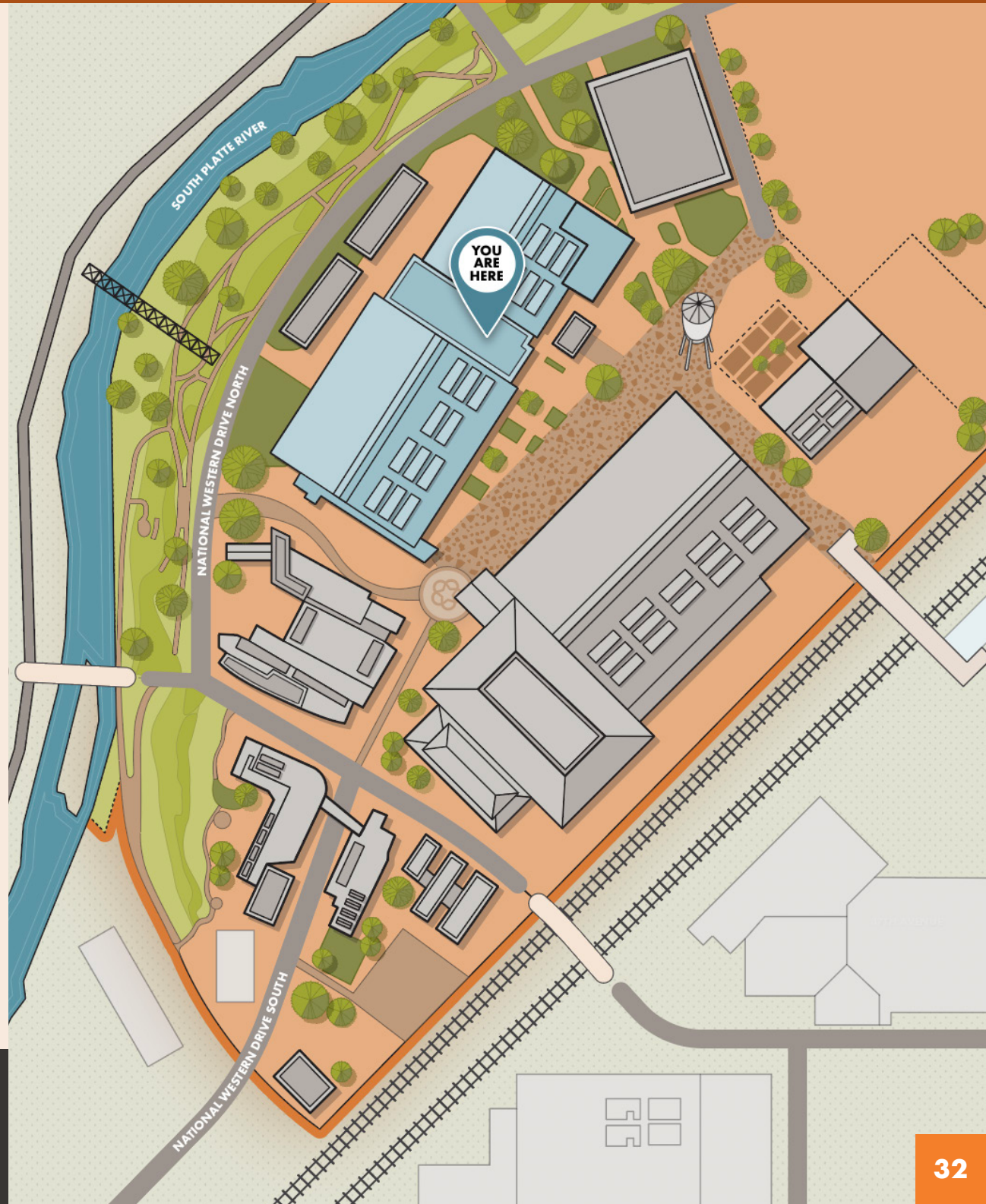
